FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Term 3 has commenced in a positive way with NAIDOC Week activities culminating with the March and ceremony at St Mary's on Friday the 15th of July. The message of *Get Up Stand UP Show up* was echoed throughout the ceremony and our students enjoyed the inspirational speeches and musical items celebrating the local culture and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples.

VARIETY CLUB VISIT: We are looking forward to hosting the Variety Club Big Bash drivers in town on Saturday the 13th of August. The Variety Club has generously donated sporting and play equipment to the school which will be presented on the day. We look forward to a great morning and welcome our school community to attend on the day, commencing at 8:30 AM (to be confirmed).

PARENT TEACHER INTERVIEWS: Parent Teacher interviews will be offered in Week 8 this term giving parents the opportunity to discuss their children's progress with teachers. This term we will be using an on-line booking system which we hope will streamline the process for parents, especially when trying to organise to see multiple teachers. YEAR SIX TRANSITIONS: Year 6 students will have the opportunity this term to be involved in transition activities at Charleville State High School. 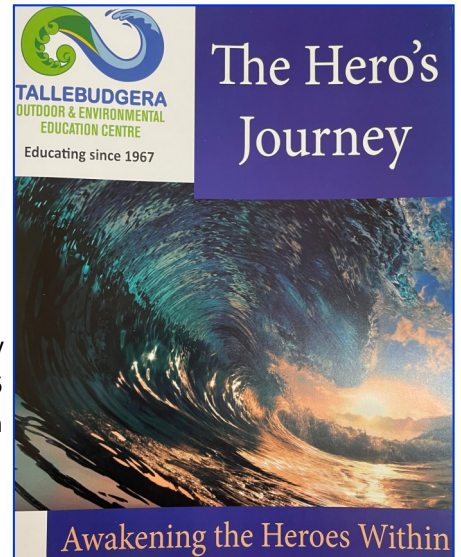
BOOK WEEK

NATURE PLAY AREA

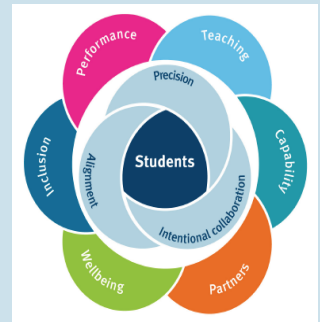

Under the School Policy section of the CSS Student Code of Conduct (p.20), the following items are explicitly prohibited at Charleville State School and will be removed if found in a student's possession:

- illegal items or weapons (e.g. guns, ammunition, knives); this includes imitation guns or weapons; potentially dangerous items (e.g. blades, rope)
- drugs (including tobacco)
- vapes
- aerosol deodorants or cans
- explosives (e.g. fireworks, flares, sparklers)
- flammable materials (e.g. fire starters, lighters)
