 - Embed inclusive practices for all students to engage in successful learning
 - Focus on differentiated reading instruction in a coordinated school wide approach
- Develop staff capacity through collegial engagement, co-planning, co-teaching and opportunities for observation and feedback.

Our initiatives include

- Funding additional resources to support teachers in leading the explicit improvement agenda of improved reading outcomes
 - Additional teacher aide time to embed inclusive practices
 - Maximise teacher aide time during reading instruction to support differentiation
- Maximising teacher numbers to include an Inclusive Practices teacher who will coach and co-teach with classroom teachers to improve student outcomes
